PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Welcome to the 2020 July/August issue of the Chrysler Collector, a little different to the usual extravaganza produced by Richard Tapp. After discussions with Richard regarding the July/August issue it was decided that with a lack of content for a normal magazine we would produce this issue the old fashioned way. Also taking into consideration the cost of printing and postage.

A big thank you to all members you have made the Membership and Registration process a huge success with everyone following the instructions laid out. Sharon and Chris are very happy campers. Hopefully all log books will be processed early in July. Please be aware that if you have not had your log book/s replaced or updated as from the 30th June 2020 you cannot drive your car on conditional registration. So if you have not yet received your log book back as yet, or you are still to send your log book in, you cannot drive your car.

I have had several communications with the CCC - Cynthia and Brian Davey. The last email received was on the 17/6/20. This was to advise that the Community Centre will be reopening on the 19/6/20. They have detailed that only 19 people will be allowed in our meeting hall. Only 19 chairs will be in this space, and will not at this stage be open for general meetings, only committee meetings with 19 or less. There will be no shared food or gathering after meeting has finished. We would have to supply a Covid-19 Plan - incorporating the cleaning of chairs, door frames, kitchen bench, toilets and tables and sanitiser, etc. Also we would have to keep a list of names and addresses of people attending. Failure to do these procedures could result in a \$5,000.00 fine. With the regulations constantly changing we will update information that we receive via our web page and face book.

We have been advised by FHMC that Business and Consumer Affairs have extended the time frame for an AGM to December 2020. Hopefully we can get this done prior to that date, but who knows. Our committee will go into caretaker mode until an AGM can be organised. Of course we are always looking for new committee members, the most important being a Vice President to take over from myself next year. This is a very important position to fill and I implore every one of our members to think about taking on this role when an election can be held. I know it can be daunting to think about taking on the role as President of this club, but we have a wonderful committee who will back you up and help to make your time as President as fulfilling and enjoyable as possible. A nomination form will be posted onto our website for downloading.

Our committee will be holding a meeting towards the end of July to discuss where we are at and how to move forward under these circumstances.

At this stage there is no information regarding the Bay to Birdwood. We will keep you posted with information as it arrives.

I hope everyone is coping with these unusual times and I look forward to seeing your smiling faces at a club meeting sometime in the future
