### General Information

Our meetings are informal and after general business there may be a guest speaker whose topic is often (but not always) car restoration related.

Supper is on a “bring a plate to share” basis and for a small fee tea, coffee and soft drinks are available. Supper is often a good time to discuss your current project or problem with other members.

Club activities are open to members, their family and friends as the social focus is family friendly and well supported.

There are eleven club meetings a year and a club run is held every month. You can use your historic or modern vehicle.

Besides the regular activities, the club also mixes with other car clubs, has weekends away and participates in tours both intra and interstate.

### What the Club offers Members

Opportunities for friendship and association with like-minded people who have an interest in veteran, vintage, classic and current Chrysler vehicles. As a club member you will be able to conditionally register unmodified historic vehicles, enabling you to use such vehicles for 90 days per year.

You receive a bi-monthly magazine which keeps you up-to-date with coming events such as club runs and swap meets. There is also a buy and sell section, plus some interesting copy sent in by members dealing with problems encountered or reporting on a successful club run.

You have access to a well maintained library of books and videos containing technical information including workshop manuals for many models over the years.
